

Children's Shopping Tour

Volunteer Instructions and Process

Thank you for volunteering for the **Children's Shopping Tour**, hosted by the **Salinas Valley Chamber of Commerce Foundation**. Please follow the steps below to complete your volunteer registration process.

Step 1: Register Online

- Visit <u>salinaschamber.com</u> to register for your <u>designated volunteer shift</u> for the Children's Shopping Tour.
- Once registered, the Chamber will have access to your email address to initiate the background check process (Step 3).

Step 2: Complete + Return the Volunteer Form & Get Fingerprinted

- Fill out the *Children's Shopping Tour Volunteer Form* completely.
- Return the completed form to the **Salinas Valley Chamber of Commerce** office: 119 E. Alisal Street, Salinas, CA 93901
 - o Note the Chamber office is open 8:00am-5:00pm with the exception of Chamber events
- When you drop off your form, Chamber staff will take your wet fingerprint directly on the form.
- The form will then be sealed with the Chamber seal for verification.
- You will receive a photocopy of the sealed form to bring with you on the day of the event.

Step 3: Background Check Email

- After registering through the Chamber website, the Chamber will have access to your email
 address to initiate the background check process. To protect the Security and Privacy of the
 information, the background checks are conducted through a third-party platform, Checkr, a
 trusted background check leader.
- In November 2025, you will receive an email invitation from Checkr to complete your background check. Please take it immediately when you receive the email as it will expire in 5 days, or it will have to be reinitiated.
- The official email will come from support@checkr.com please check your inbox and spam folder.
- The platform will ask for the following information:
 - First and Last Name
 - Date of Birth (DOB)
 - Social Security Number (SSN)





- The Background Check must be completed two weeks before the Children's Shopping Tour, and it takes **less than 2 minutes** to complete.
 - Note: If your current place of employment (for example, a school district, law enforcement agency, or public safety organization) has already completed a Live Scan/background check as a condition of employment, proof of employment in that field will meet the background check requirement you do not need to complete an additional Checkr screening. Please let Chamber staff know, so it can be documented with your form. (Examples include: Peace Officer ID, Teacher/Admin ID, Healthcare Provider ID)
 - o If you have been Live Scanned independently (not through an employer), you will need to provide proof of your completed Background Check or Live Scan for verification.
 - Note: the Chamber Foundation is covering the cost of background checks through Checkr, there is no fee for the volunteer.

Step 4: Event Day Check-In

- The event will be held on **Saturday, December 13, 2025**, from **7:00 AM to 12:00 Noon** at **Northridge Mall** (near the former Sears and Planet Fitness).
- Arrive at your designated check-in time with:
 - o A valid photo ID, and
 - o Your photocopy of the Chamber-sealed volunteer form.
- Volunteers will be paired with children and provided with:
 - The child's "needs list,"
 - o Shopping funds via a Gift Card, and
 - Store discount information.
- (Please note, no walk-in volunteers will be accepted for the safety of the children).

Step 5: Make a Difference!

Help your assigned child shop for new clothing. For many, this is their first experience shopping for new clothes — your time and kindness will help create lasting holiday memories.

Chamber staff will also be available to answer questions about the volunteer process.
